

POLLUTION INCIDENT RESPONSE MANAGEMENT PLAN

ARDLEN QUARRY

The Ardglen quarry is located on the northern slopes of the Liverpool Range in the Liverpool Plains Shire LGA (just over the Upper Hunter LGA boundary), approximately 35 km north of Scone, NSW.

In the event that a pollution incident occurs where actual or potential material harm to the environment is caused or threatened, the following external bodies will be contacted by the nominated site representative, in this order.
